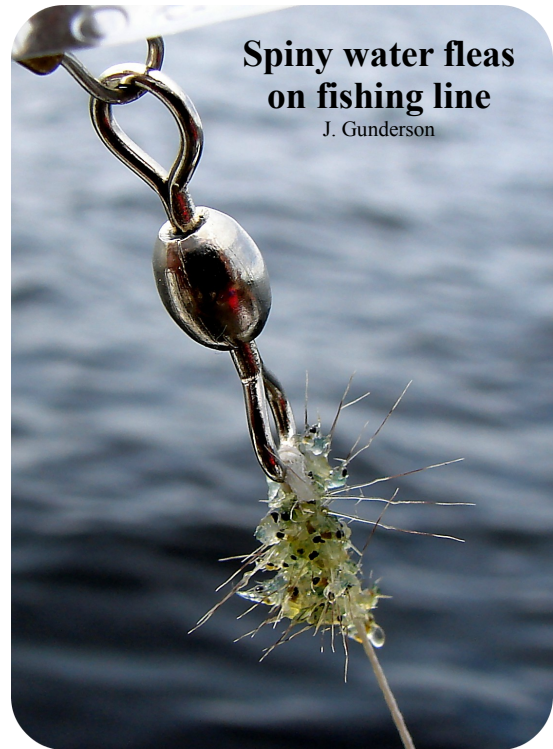


Help Stop the Spread of Spiny Waterflea

Anglers beware!

This invader competes with fish for food.

- Hamilton County invasions: Lake Pleasant, Piseco Lake, Sacandaga Lake. Adirondack invasions: Great Sacandaga Lake, Lake George, Peck Lake and Stewarts Bridge Reservoir.
- Not harmful to humans, pets, or drinking water.
- Fouls fishing gear and prevents fish from being landed.
- Competes with native fish for food.
- Spreads to other waterbodies on down rigging cables, fishing line, anchor ropes, and watercraft, and in bait buckets, live wells, bilge water.

No Control Exists. Please Stop their Spread!

- **Check** and remove visible plants, animals, and mud from your boat, trailer, and equipment. Dispose of in the trash or on dry land.
- **Drain** water from bilge, motor, livewells, bait buckets, ballast tanks, kayaks, and canoes.
- **Clean & Dry** your watercraft and gear with hot (greater than 140°F) water, spray with high pressure water, or disinfect with a 5% bleach solution. Dry at least 5 days.
